## Safety Policies and Procedures

### Air Quality Policy

The JDL will use <https://wasmoke.blogspot.com/> to determine air quality. Below is the poor air quality procedure for the JDL.

If poor air quality is in the forecast, the JDL will enact the following procedures.

- 3 hours prior to any kickoff, the JDL Director will check the site listed above. If the nearest available monitor to the matchday field indicates the following numbers;
  - 0-101: Games will proceed as normal
  - 101-120: Games will proceed with 18-minute halves
  - 121+: Games will be canceled for this match location
- The JDL reserve the right to cancel games before or after the 3-hour mark. The JDL may consider canceling games prior to the 3-hour mark if the forecast is well beyond the 121 mark and shows no signs of subsiding.
- Games may be canceled after the 3-hour mark if conditions are shifting negatively just prior to kickoff. This decision must be made in agreement with both Head Coaches and the referee on the field. Teams are required to show up to the field if matches are not canceled in order to make this decision.
